  - Interview




- More than 220 attendees and over 1/4 were males!

There were not only female participants but also many male participants in the event. # **Key success factors**

### The strong support from leaders

- CIGRE President, TC Chairman, Sectary, elected TC Chairman, committee chair...
- IEEE PES president and past president

### The strong support from CIGRE Central Office

- Organisation (venue, tea & coffee, photographer...)
- Service during the event

### Perspective

- The selection of the sessions, topics and speakers were from the perspective of audiences
- Focused on the current and future career challenges & opportunities in power and energy industry, especially for women engineers
- Provide opportunities to setup links with outstanding leaders to obtain guidance and suggestions

# **Key success factors**

#### Diversity

- The speakers are **industry leaders** from different countries
- Not only females but also males!
- More than **220** attendees from all over the world
- The attendees were involved through **interview** and **networking session** to express their opinions and talk to role models and leaders

#### Media

- Dissemination in CIGRE KMS, Linkedin WIE Group, CIGRE Linkedin account
- Summary report published in CIGRE website and Electra
- The report has been translated into Chinese and circulated in China

#### Service

- The service of the event was great (registration, sending brochures, reply inquiries)
- Circulated the presentations, photos and report to the attendees quickly

# Things we can do better for future WIE events

- Due to the big attendance during the WIE forum
  - The outdoor registration took a long time
  - The souvenirs were not enough for the attendees
  - The seats were not enough for the attendees
- The time slots for networking session (coffee breaks) were too tight
- Time control of some sessions were not good enough
- Suggestions
  - Make **online registration** in the system of Paris Session so that we can know the number of the attendees and prepare the venue, souvenirs, seats, coffee, snacks...
  - Make **online survey** after the WIE forum
  - Make Live Stream Broadcast if possible (like IEEE General Meeting LiveStreaming)
  - Inform the speakers to practice in advance to control the time
  - Need volunteers during the event (by involving young people)





# Future plan

 The society is moving towards diversification, and CIGRE has changed its slogan to show its determination to transform. With the active participation of female members, giving full play to women's advantages in innovation and social integration will be very important for the future development of the organization.

#### Establish new WIE Taskforce

- Recommend Khayakazi Dioka to be the next Chair of the TF
- Involve more members from NC and TC
- Create subgroups in the TF to manage different sessions (2-3 persons in each subgroup)

- Status of WIE (with the support from STC & AC & Headquarter)
- Challenges
- Demand from WIE



# Future plan

- Increase WIE in CIGRE
  - Working group: Encourage more women to be Convenor and Sectary
  - Steering Committee: More participation
  - National Committee: More participation and establish local WIE
  - Play the role of TC to support and encourage women
  - Encourage each SC to have a WiE slot in their meetings and indicate plans to increase participation.
  - Increase/emphasize use of video conferencing for WG meetings
- Encourage WIE branch in each NC
  - WIE events: Symposium, Colloquium, Forum, Seminar
  - Communication
  - Career development and problem solving
